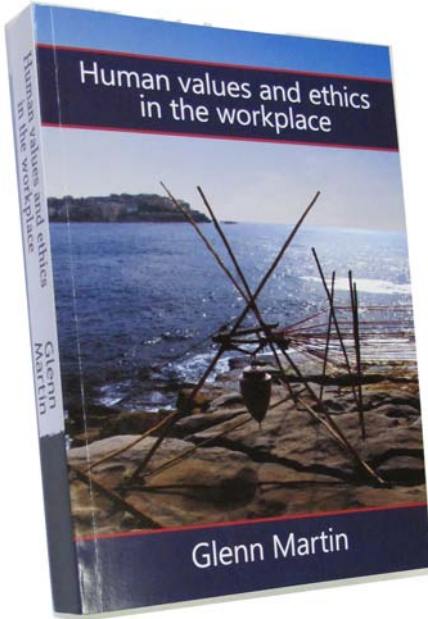


Human values and ethics in the workplace
